## **Instructions for the Transcript Verification Form**

The attached transcript includes a record of your high school performance and your three-year grade point average. The transcript is designated "unofficial" because it will not be accepted by any school, college or employer; only **transcripts mailed directly** from Roslyn High School are considered "official".

You have been sent a copy of your transcript for two basic reasons:

- 1. You should be aware of what the official record shows about your high school performance to date.
- 2. You should check the accuracy of the courses listed, the grades recorded and the three-year grade point average listed as GPA.

## **Check Course Listings**:

- 1. Check that every course you have taken has been listed on the transcript.
- 2. Check that no additional courses have been listed.
- 3. Check that each of the grades reported are correct.

## Calculating the GPA (Grade Point Average):

In order for you to calculate your grade point average accurately, you should be aware of the guidelines used by Roslyn High School.

- 1. Final grades in all subjects in grades 9-11 are included. High pass/pass/no credit grades are not included in this calculation.
- 2. Failing grades are included when the subject is not repeated. If the course is repeated during the school year or during summer school, <u>both grades are</u> used in calculating the GPA.
- 3. When students retake a regents exam without repeating the course, the GPA will be recalculated. Both regents grades appear on the transcript.
- 4. Grades for ½ credit courses are only given ½ weight and grades for ¼ courses are only given ¼ weight (for example: 100 is a 50 for a ½ credit course and 100 is a 25 for a ¼ credit course)
- 5. Steps to follow to verify your unweighted GPA:
  - Add the value for each course
  - Divide the total by the number of credits
  - The result of the division should correspond to the GPA as indicated on your transcript.
- 6. Steps to follow to verify your weighted GPA: All courses are weighted retroactively. Final course averages will be multiplied by a numerical amount depending on the level of the course. (Please note the examples for a final course average of 95 listed below.)
  - Regents Level Courses: x = 1.00 = 95.0
  - Honors or Accelerated Courses: x 1.08 (95 average x 1.08 = 102.6)
  - Research Honors Courses: x = 1.09 = 103.5
  - Advanced Placement Courses: x = 1.10 = 104.5
